NONPROFIT LEADERSHIP DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM
NOW OPEN FOR REGISTRATION

CINCINNATI, OH, June 25, 2014 – Executive Service Corps of Cincinnati (ESCC) and Talbert House are offering its nine-month leadership and skills development training program targeted to executive directors and senior staff management of nonprofit organizations in the Greater Cincinnati and Northern Kentucky area.

Collectively, ESCC and Talbert House have graduated 228 nonprofit leaders in the past several years. This is the second year of the merged program. Registration for EXCEL is now open and will continue until July 15. Full-day workshops will be held at Interact for Health the second Friday of the month beginning in October 2014 and running through May 2015. In addition to the monthly workshops, the program will also include a September 19-20 leadership experience at Camp Joy. With the generous support of local funders, the cost of EXCEL is \$1100.
