### **Executive Service Corps of Cincinnati announces new leadership**

#### Arlene T. Herman named Interim Executive Director

CINCINNATI, OH, October 9, 2014 – Arlene T. Herman has been named Interim Executive Director, Executive Service Corps of Cincinnati, it was announced today by Doug Bolton, incoming ESCC Board Chair.

“As ESCC continues its search for a full-time executive director/CEO,” Bolton said, “we are pleased to have the talents of Arlene Herman on board. Herman is the former CEO of Family Service of the Cincinnati Area dba LifePoint Solutions. She has the background, experience and in-depth knowledge of the nonprofit sector to bring great value to this position.”

Prior to retirement, Herman initiated and co-led a merger with Greater Cincinnati Behavioral Health and Clermont Recovery Center, in response to the changing environment of behavioral health. Over Herman’s tenure as CEO, Family Service grew from a \$3 million nonprofit to becoming a division of a \$31 million operation. She had been with the agency since 1985. Arlene is married to Aubrey Herman, an ESCC board member. Aubrey will take a leave of absence while Arlene is serving as the interim director.

Executive Service Corps of Cincinnati (ESCC) is dedicated to enhancing the lives of all individuals in the Greater Cincinnati and Northern Kentucky area. The nonprofit organization, headquartered in Blue Ash, OH, gives back to the community by transferring knowledge and expertise through consulting, coaching and leadership development. The organization, founded in 1995, has served more than 550 local nonprofit organizations and currently has 116 members who volunteer their services.
